SC DY SCI X25: Dairy Records Management

A motion was made by Bohnhoff and seconded by Bednarak to approve the new course **SC\_DY SCI X25.** The committee requested the following changes be made to the proposal:

- yes should be checked to show the proposal was approved by the department committee,
- item 1 should read: SC\_DY SCI X25,
- item 5 should read Every year,
- item 7 the word "enterprise" in the capsule statement revised by Bohnhoff should be changed to "enterprises,"
- the top left corner of page 2 should be changed to show the course number SC DY SCI X25,
- item 16 must be clarified,
- item 17 should be answered "No,"
- item 18 needs a complete syllabus with grading scale, objectives, readings and assessments (Bohnhoff agreed to consult with Halbach on this.)

**The motion was withdrawn.** After discussion, the motion to approve the new course proposal for **SC\_DY SCI X25** was withdrawn due to the need to address the items listed above and, primarily the course overlap issue in all Farm and Industry Short Course proposals.

# SC\_SOIL SCI X51: Introductory Soils

Request: change credits from 2 to 1 and move it to the

3-week Winter Session

A motion was made by Bohnhoff and seconded by Jackson to approve the course change to **SC\_SOIL SCI X51**. The committee requested the following changes be made to the proposal:

- yes should be checked to show the proposal was approved by the department committee,
- item 1 should be listed as **SC\_SOIL SCI X51** (change top of page 2 also),
- item 2 (course title) needs to be filled out,
- item 5 layout revisions made by Bohnhoff are acceptable,
- revisions to capsule statement made by Bohnhoff are acceptable,
- item 7 shows no change to the program; committee questions this statement based on the fact that the credits are being reduced from 2 to 1,
- item 8 must be addressed.
- Item 13A should be marked "No"

- item 1 should be listed as **SC SOIL SCI X52**(change top of page 2 also),
- item 2 (course title) should be filled out,
- item 5 layout revisions made by Bohnhoff are acceptable,
- item 5 capsule statement must not exceed 40 words; the course description should match the title; the committee questioned whether this is the current or new course description; the description does not match the syllabus,
- item 6 needs more explanation/longer sentence,
- item 7 needs more explanation,
- item 8 must be addressed.
- item 13A should be marked "No" and R. Wolkowski should be removed from item B,
- a complete syllabus must be attached (grading scale, objectives, readings and assessments.)

- a complete grading scale should be part of the syllabus (A-F with percentages,)
- there must be justification on the syllabus indicating a change in workload for the credit variance (what is required of students for 3 credits; what is required of students for 2 credits,)
- the learning objectives need to be specified discretely.
