DISCUSSION ITEMS

- 10. CALS International Studies Requirement
 - Sarah Pfatteicher, Susan Huber Miller, and Nikki Bollig shared background information about the International Studies requirement.
 - o Requirement was established over 20 years ago and the course list has grown substantially
 - 133 courses meet the requirement but only 20 or so are CALS courses
 - o 80% of the graduates in the last 5 years with non CALS courses
 - o Large number of courses makes it difficult to assess learning outcomes
 - Potential goals of a project to revisit the requirement include:
 - o Shorten the list and consider limiting to CALS courses
 - Align to CALS priority themes
 - o Revise criteria and define measurable learning outcomes
 - Determine process for review of requirement and incorporation of CALS international field studies
 - Barak and Balster volunteered to participate on sub-committee charged with reviewing the International Studies requirement on behalf of the Associate Dean

11. New Online Course Proposal
